In addition, a Virginia Tech degree is highly respected by the top graduate programs as well as corporate America.

The National Capital Region Chapter of the Virginia Tech Alumni Association plans to award several merit-based scholarships to graduating seniors coming from high schools in the counties of Fairfax or Arlington, VA or Prince George's or Montgomery, MD; the cities of Fairfax, Falls Church, or Alexandria, VA or Washington, DC, who will enter Virginia Tech as freshmen in the fall of 2011.

Although the scholarship amounts have yet to be set for this year, the average scholarship amount has been \$3,000 and will be paid via a credit to the scholarship recipient's student account in two equal installments before both the fall and spring semesters of their freshman year. Winners will also be published on our website and through the news media, receive a certificate, and will be invited to a reception in their honor. Upon acceptance to Virginia Tech, qualified applicants will automatically be sent information via email with a link to the application.

All completed scholarship applications must be received by May 13, 2011. We will notify all applicants, regardless if they win a scholarship or not, by June 10, 2011.

The minimum requirements for the scholarship are:

3.75 G.P.A. or higher, and
1300 S.A.T. or 28 ACT score or higher
